

Membership



The National Governing Body of Orienteering (British Orienteering) has two categories of Membership:

- Local Membership of British Orienteering and
- National Membership of British Orienteering.

These are the only classifications of membership available through London Orienteering Klubb (LOK), unless you are already a member of British Orienteering through another club. If this is the case, please contact the Membership Secretary for further details.

Depending on how frequently you orienteer, it will be cheaper for you to enter events by becoming a British Orienteering member. Together with entry discounts there are also a number of other personal benefits to becoming a British Orienteering member:

Benefits of becoming a Local Member of British Orienteering:

- Insurance cover (liability to 3rd parties) at events registered with British Orienteering
- Biannual Newsletter
- Eligibility to compete in the JK, national, regional and district events
- Discounted entry to regional and district events within your club's region only
- Papers and vote at the British Orienteering AGM
- Discounts from national companies through the member benefit scheme

Benefits of becoming a National Member of British Orienteering: (Extra benefits highlighted in bold)

- Insurance cover (liability to 3rd parties) at events registered with British Orienteering
- **Quarterly issue of the British Orienteering magazine, Focus**
- Eligibility to compete in the **British Championships**, JK, national, regional and district events
- Discounted entry to the **JK, national**, regional and district events **in all regions**
- Papers and vote at the British Orienteering AGM
- Discounts from national companies through the member benefit scheme
- **World Championships brochure**

Benefits of a Strong National Governing Body

British Orienteering is the National Governing Body (NGB) for orienteering in the UK; through its Council, committees, volunteers and staff it provides strategic direction and manages and promotes the development of the sport. By being a member of the NGB you are strengthening the voice of orienteering. For more detailed information on British Orienteering please refer to the web site (www.britishorienteering.org.uk).

Entry discounts will be £2 per adult for 2010, thus a senior non-British Orienteering member taking part in more than three events within their region would begin to save money by taking out Local Membership of British Orienteering.

Please note that you will need to show your British Orienteering membership card when entering events in order to receive the discount.
